We have two networks - the bandwidth from one is DDoS protected. Typically, we run GRE tunnels from that network to another unprotected network. We terminate it at the switch level, but this particular switch doesn't support GRE, so we need a way to get it to work without running GRE on the switch.

Would RIP/OSPF be needed if egress traffic is allowed to flow out naturally through the switch itself (as opposed to going back out the GRE tunnel)? The only reason that the GRE tunnel exists is to provide IP space (a /27, too small to announce) and DDoS mitigation
